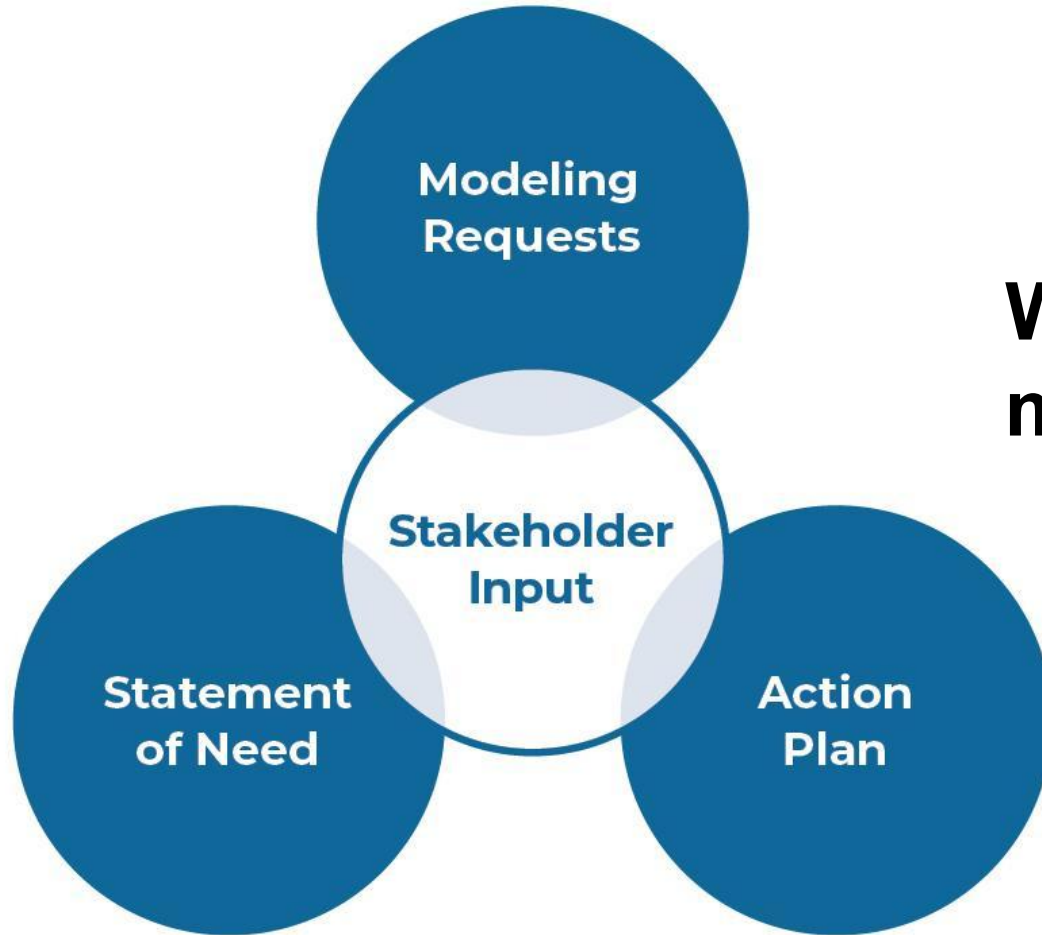

STATEMENT OF NEED and ACTION PLAN

Statement of Need

- What resources (by type and amount) PNM needs to reliably meet customer demands and state policies
- Should take a broad view of the evolving needs of the system
- Ensures a future grid that is cost effective, reliable, and meets state policies

Action Plan

- Specific steps over the next 3 years to implement the resource plan
- Actions for new generation - competitive bidding and/or contracting activities
- Status report from prior action plan
